You can also visit samaritanspurse.org for more gift ideas for the boxes.

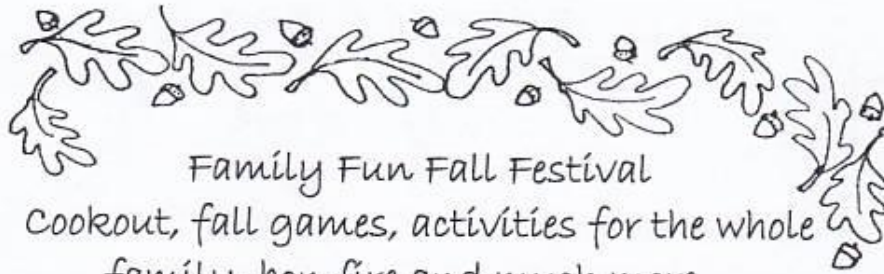
Please feel free to take more than one box if you want to and join us as we reach out to these children and show God's love to them.
